Let's Define Our Key Groups, Clearly

Veterans

Men and women who served in the U.S. Armed Forces and are now facing housing instability, joblessness, trauma recovery, or reentry challenges.

First Responders

Police, firefighters, EMTs, and paramedics—especially those who are retired, disabled, or experiencing mental health or economic hardship post-service.

Nonprofit Workers

Individuals who have served in the nonprofit sector—often underpaid, overextended, or burned out—now seeking transition support, career shifts, or wellness recovery services.

At-Risk Youth

Young people ages 16–25 who are disconnected from school, family, or employment and are at increased risk of homelessness, incarceration, or long-term poverty. This includes youth aging out of foster care or reentering society from juvenile programs.

Individuals Transitioning from Social Services

Adults recently released from incarceration, rehab, domestic violence shelters, or long-term care who are rebuilding their lives without stable support systems. Veterans, first responders, and those served by shelters, rescue missions, and food banks.

We address immediate needs like food, clothing, and stability, while offering free training, mentorship, and on-the-job preparation in podcasting, media, and music production. Our mission is to equip people with both the tools and the confidence to build meaningful careers, share their stories, and achieve long-term self-sufficiency.

Through compassionate guidance and real-world creative outlets, we help people build confidence, contribute to their communities, and find new paths forward. Whether someone is stepping up to the mic for the first time or picking up the pieces of a difficult season, Oasis Voices is here to walk alongside them.
